WHAT IS HEON?

The Higher Education Outreach Network (HEON) is a partnership of local organisations including universities and colleges working in Surrey and North East Hampshire.

HEON is part of the Uni Connect Programme funded by the Office for Students, working towards the government's aim of supporting an increase in the number of young people from under-represented groups who go into higher education.

HEON and our partner organisations offer impartial advice and information on higher education and progression routes by delivering outreach activity such as HE information talks,



TARGETING STUDENTS

Our programme of events aims to increase the number of students from our target geographical wards progressing to Higher Education.

In order to do this, we prioritise delivery to young people from 11 specific wards across Surrey and North East Hampshire. The Office for Students has identified these wards as areas where the proportion of young people progressing to higher education is low overall, and lower than expected given GCSE attainment levels. HEON's 11 target wards are:

- Ashford North & Chertsey St Ann's
- Stanwell South Hoe Valley

- Old Dean
- Preston
