All masterclasses are **FREE** of charge, subject to selection criteria*, and are available in **English** and **Maths** along with **revision skills**.

What are the Y11 GCSE Revision Masterclasses?

The Masterclasses are a series of virtual GCSE revision and preparation sessions in English and Maths. Led by educational consultants with a wealth of experience within teaching and assessment, the masterclasses will cover common topics and themes which are applicable to all exam boards. Each masterclass is 60 minutes, followed by an additional 30 minutes of revisions techniques and strategies to employ in preparation for examinations. All participants enrolled on to the virtual series will then be invited to the University of Surrey in February half-term to attend an exclusive revision day led by the consultants.

Eligibility Criteria

You are eligible for Y11 GCSE Masterclasses if you are in Year 11 and meet one of the following criteria:

- You live in an area of higher deprivation as measured by postcode (IMD Deciles 1 or 2*).
- You live in an area of low progression into higher education (POLAR4 Q1*).
- You have received Free School Meals within the last 6 years.
- You have a diagnosed disability or long-term health condition.
- You are a forced migrant (a refugee or an asylumseeking young person).
- You are a young carer (you care for a friend or family member who, due to illness, disability, a mental health problem, or an addiction, cannot cope without your support).
- You are care experienced (you have spent time in local authority care, in a residential children's home, have been looked after at home by a supervision order or have lived with relatives under kinship care).
- You are from a Gypsy, Roma, Traveller, Showperson or Boater community.

*Indices of Multiple Deprivation are commonly used datasets within the UK to classify the relative deprivation within smaller areas. You can find an IMD look-up tool on our website. To be eligible, you must live in an IMD Decile 1 or 2 postcode. **POLAR4 classifies the progression rate of young people in higher education within local areas across the UK. You can find a POLAR4 look up tool on our website. To be eligible, you must live in a POLAR4 Quintile 1 postcode.

- They have experience of living within care
- They are a forced migrant (a refugee or an asylum-seeking young person)
- They are from a Gypsy, Roma, Traveller, Showperson or Boater community
